Meet Rules and Conditions

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The competition is a Level 4 licensed meet, held under ASA Laws and Technical Rules.
2. All swimmers must be ASA Members but can be Category 1 or Category 2 members
3. The promoter is the County Development Secretary (Tim Millett) on behalf of Beccles Town SC.
4. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at the venue.
5. Beccles Town SC will not be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.
6. The pool is a 25m pool and anti-wave devices will be in place. The event will be run using AOE.
7. Over the top starts will be used at the referee's discretion.
8. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and Referee, subject to ASA Laws, Regulations and the ASA Technical Rules of Racing.

ENTRIES

9. A maximum of 7 other clubs will be invited by the promoter, closing date 6/4/2018.
10. All entries are £3 per event.
11. Times must have been achieved within the past 12 months.
12. Only entries made electronically will be considered. All entries from a club shall be consolidated by a club official and made using the electronic entry. Entries are to be emailed to tim.kingfishers@hotmail.com
13. Submission of an electronic entry file will be regarded as full acceptance and agreement to all conditions within this entry pack.
14. Acknowledgement and acceptance of a correctly submitted entry shall be listed on the Clubs webpage and emailed out to the club official. Clubs will have 7 days from that date that entries are posted to check the received entries and report errors, after which a final accepted entry list will be published and no further corrections allowed.
15. Dependent on the number of entries, the Promoter reserves the right to reject entries to ensure the competition runs within the allowed time scale. If necessary to reject entries the slowest entries, by age group and event, will be rejected first.
16. Entries to the meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998 to the holding of personal information on computer, will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the Meet on application to the Promoter.

AGE GROUPS & AWARDS

17. Age groups for qualifying are 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and over.
18. Age group for results are 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and over.
19. A medal will be awards to the first 3 swimmers in each age group in each event.
20. All events will be heat declared winners (HDW).
21. Age for the meet will be age at 28th April 2018
22. Events will be 50m all strokes, 100m Freestyle, 100 IM, 200 Free and 200 IM
23. Heats will be swum as mixed age with swimmers seeded by entry times.

PHOTOGRAPHY

1. No photography is permitted in the changing rooms
2. We ask swimmers and spectators wishing to take photographs and videos to ensure that they are aware of the ASA guidelines and respect them.
